Children's Corner

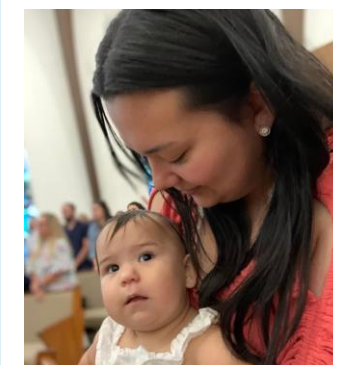

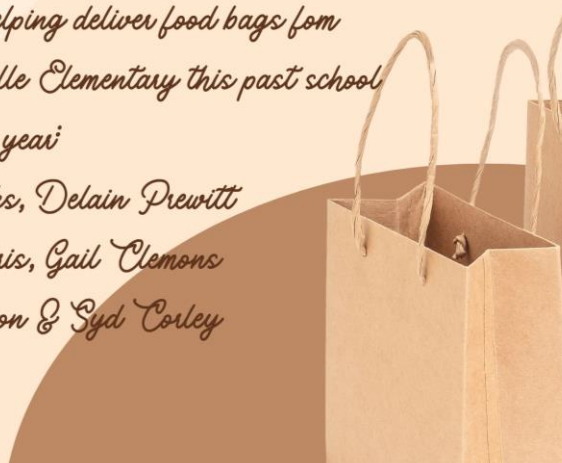
